Fees of Collector

§. The twenty-ninth section of the act entitled "an act to reduce the number of town officers, and town & county expenses, and to prevent abuses in auditing town & county accounts, passed May 10th 1845" is ^{herely} amended so as to allow town collectors two per cent, fees on all voluntary payments made to them within the thirty days, as now provided by law in all cases where the aggregate amount to be collected by warrants, when into their hands shall not exceed the sum of two thousand dollars.

in said County of Cayuga.

YOU are hereby commanded to collect from the several persons named in the Assessment Roll to which this Warrant is annexed, the several sums mentioned and set down in the last column of the said Roll, opposite to their respective names; and you are hereby authorized in case any person named in the said Assessment Roll shall refuse or neglect to pay his tax, to levy the same by distress, and sale of the goods and chattels of such person; and you are hereby directed and required, on or before the first day of February next out of the monies so to be collected to pay to the Superintendent of Common Schools of said town, the sum of *Four hundred* and to the Commissioners of Highways of the said town, the sum of *Two hundred & fifty* and also the monies raised therein to defray any other town expenses, and to be paid to the Supervisor of said town. And you are further directed and required, on or before the said first day of February next, to pay to the Treasurer of said county the residue of the said monies so to be collected.

Issued under the hands and seals of the Board of Supervisors of said county, (or a majority of them,) at *Auburn* the *6th* day of *December* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Fifty*
