YOU are hereby commanded to collect from the several persons named in the Assessment Roll to which this Warrant is annexed, the several sums mentioned and set down in the last column of the said Roll, opposite to their respective names; and you are hereby authorized in case any person named in the said Assessment Roll shall refuse or neglect to pay his tax, to levy the same by distress, and sale of the goods and chattels of such person; and you are hereby directed and required, on or before the first day of February next out of the monies so to be collected to pay to the Superintendent of Common Schools of said town, the sum of ~~Two hundred & fifth~~ Four hundred & ~~sixty nine dollars~~ ^{and} ~~cents~~ and to the Commissioners of Highways and also the monies raised therein to defray any other town expenses, and to be paid to the Supervisor of said town.
